### **OUR CLIMATE**

We are blessed with a particularly good climate here in South Africa. Our temperature tends to range high in summer and varies between  $30^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $40^{\circ}\text{C}$ . In the winter seasons, temperatures can cool down to between  $15^{\circ}\text{C}$  and  $25^{\circ}\text{C}$  during the day. All our facilities offer air-conditioning for those warm summer days.

The sun rises at 05:30 and sets at 18:10. Our rainfall season is during November to February.

## **ACTIVITIES AT MANANGA**

Hunting and safaris are the main attractions during your visit with us. At Mananga Safaris, you can hunt with our professional hunters. Furthermore, you are allowed to bring your own rifles; however, you can rent rifles from us. Please advise prior to your arrival whether you would like to rent rifles and ammunition from Mananga.

Apart from hunting, and to name a few activities, we offer game drives, bush walks and fishing for our non-hunters and observers.

### **EXCURSIONS**

We can gladly arrange a one-day excursion to the nearby Kruger National Park or the Old African Kingdom Heritage Site in Mapungubwe. Please see our Price List for more non-hunting activities and applicable rates.

### **MEALS & SERVICES**

When at camp, we provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily. Soft drinks, mineral water and beer are also included in our daily rates. Unfortunately, strong alcoholic drinks are not provided by Mananga Safaris, but you are more than welcome to bring your own.

During excursions, such as Kruger National Park and Mapungubwe, we will pack a lunch box with sandwiches. Should you prefer to dine at any of the restaurants or shops along the way, you will be liable for your own costs. The meals at the camp are mostly game, meat and chicken. Please inform us beforehand about any special dietary needs.

Our guestrooms are serviced daily, and a daily laundry service is also included. If you are interested in our laundry services, please complete the form provided. You will find these forms inside the folders in your room. Regrettably, no washing will be done without a completed form.

### **FACILITIES**

The Mbuyu Camp can accommodate a maximum of fourteen guests simultaneously, and we require a minimum of two people per visit. The dining area, bar and swimming pool are at your disposal at any time. We have wi-fi services available in the camp. Unfortunately, the mobile coverage is problematic; nevertheless, there are selective areas in the camp with adequate signal.

### **MEDICATION & PRESCRIPTION DRUGS**

Musina has been flagged as a malaria area. But we are happy to inform you that, during all the years we have been in operation, we have never had any reported case of clients infected with malaria while visiting Mananga Safaris.

We do not discourage our guests to take malaria medication, as the effects differ from person to person. We advise you to inform your personal physician that you will be visiting a malaria area for further advice. All our rooms have air-conditioning, which aids against mosquitoes. Insect repellent is also supplied in the rooms. Furthermore, our rooms are fumigated on a regular basis

#### **OUR ROOMS**

Currently we have seven units in the Mbuyu Camp. Each unit can comfortably sleep two people. Three of our units are en-suite, where the remaining four rooms offer two detached bathrooms to share, equipped with showers.

## **OUR LOCATION & DIRECTIONS**

Mananga Safaris is located in the Limpopo Province, approximately twenty kilometres from Musina Town and approximately five hundred kilometres (five-hour drive) from O.R. Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg.

Our closest airport is Gateway International in Polokwane, which is two hundred kilometres (two-hour drive) from Musina. We do offer transport services, and our prices are available on our Price List. Alternatively, you have the option to rent your own vehicle. There is an Avis Rental Service available in Musina Town.

#### **CURRENCY**

The local currency is South African Rand (R). All major Credit Cards are widely accepted in town and throughout the country. Our invoices are charged in either Euro ( $\mathfrak E$ ) or US $\mathfrak P$ , depending on the currency of your original quotation.
